NOTICE IS GIVEN that we are applying to the Consistory Court of the diocese for permission to carry out the following:

Due to the introduction of an enlarged childrens area to accomodate a new Initiative of a 'Mums and Tots' session on a Monday morning we have found ourselves in a situation where we have literally run out of room for all of the pews. We are therefore proposing to dispose of 11 pews to make space for the remaining, usable pews. These pews are of no significant interest as shown in the Statement of Significance. We have identified that 5 of these surplus pews will find a new home in a chapel within Milton Keynes with the balance being sold to various outlets.
